- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order by Director Fleisher at 6:03 p.m. A quorum of five (5) Directors were present or participating. No additional conflict disclosures were stated by the Directors.
- 2. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Director Fleischer moved that the Board approve the agenda as presented. Following a second by Director King, and upon a vote taken the motion carried unanimously.

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- 3. <u>Consent Agenda</u>: Director Ela moved that the Board approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of the following items, as presented:

  - Ratify the payment of claims for the period ending February 28, 2023:

Upon a second by Director Mansfield a vote was taken, and the motion carried unanimously.

## 5. Discussion / Action Items:

- A. <u>Centennial Water Interconnect Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV):</u> Mr. Schlegel stated that Mulhern has begun planning for the installation of the PRV and that the surveyor is to be on site this week to complete the survey and then develop drawing for the project. Glacier Construction has been contacted and they are waiting for drawings / plans so that parts can be ordered for the installation.
- B. 2023 Rate & Fee Discussion: Director Fleischer opened the requisite Public Hearing at 6:07 pm. The Directors discussed the Denver Water Rate & Fee structure for 2023 and the need to keep pace with water and equipment charges. No public comment was received, and Director Fleischer closed the Public Hearing at 6:20 pm. Following discussion, the choice was made to increase the three (3) water use tier rates to cover the increased charges form Denver Water. Director Fleischer moved that the Board approve and adopt Resolution No. 2023-03-01 Approving the Schedule of Fees for 2023 increasing Water Use Fees to:
